



## **ARG EMPLOYEES SCHOLARSHIP** **FUND ELIGIBILITY**

**TO QUALIFY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST BE ENROLLED IN A POST SECONDARY SCHOOL AND YOUR PARENT, GRANDPARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN SHALL BE EMPLOYED AT ARG FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. CANDIDATE SHOULD PLAY AN ACTIVE ROLE IN HIS/HER CHURCH, SCHOOL AND/OR COMMUNITY. THE CANDIDATE SHALL ALSO PROVIDE A NARRATIVE OF THEIR CAREER GOALS AND DOCUMENTATION THAT THEY HAVE MAINTAINED A HIGH ACADEMIC STANDARD (3.0/4.0 SCALE).**

For consideration, all ARG Scholarship applications must be returned to your guidance office by **March 1**. There will be no exceptions. The Scholarship Selection Committee, appointed by the Board of Directors of the McKean County Community Foundation, will review and finalize the scholarship recipient.

### **ARG EMPLOYEES SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

The ARG Employees Scholarship Fund was established by the ARG Employees Scholarship Committee in recognition of the hard work and determination demonstrated by its many employees, Leadership Team and owner. ARG will support the scholarship from proceeds raised through the annual ARG Golf Tournament and/or any other fund-raisers established for this purpose.

### **TERMS FOR SCHOLARSHIP**

The committee will grant the **ARG Employees Scholarship** as instructed. The selection of students to receive scholarship grants shall be made by the committee without regard to race, religion or sex of the applicant or their political perspectives. The committee will not place restrictions upon a candidate's choice of college, university or vocational school.

The committee shall require, prior to the disbursement of any scholarship, proof that the scholarship recipient is actually enrolled as a student at the educational institution for which the grant is made, and all scholarship grants shall be paid only to the institution attended by the recipient and never directly to the recipient. This grant covers tuition, fees and books for the applicable quarter.

**The McKean County Community Foundation, an affiliate of the Community Foundation of the Northern Alleghenies, is an approved PATH Program participant. *If you are awarded a scholarship of at least \$200 from the Community Foundation, we will submit your name to AES/PHEAA for additional scholarship funding through PATH. To be eligible for the PATH award, you must meet the following criteria: be enrolled in an approved Pennsylvania college or career school; be a State Grant recipient and have a Federal Student Loan; and demonstrate financial need for a PATH Program Grant. PATH grants will not exceed the Maximum State Grant for the particular academic year.***
